Possible use of photographs

NAS publications: for example, NAS-produced leaflets and books, our magazine *Communication*.

Fundraising: as part of fundraising campaigns, for example, a campaign leaflet.

Website: the NAS website (incorporating the Autism Services Directory and Signpost) provides information on autistic spectrum disorders (ASDs) and the services we provide.

Advertisements: photos may be needed to accompany NAS recruitment advertisements, for example.

Direct mail campaigns: photos may help illustrate NAS requests for donations, for example.

Television: the NAS may receive a request for a photo to accompany a news item about ASDs, for example.

External magazines and newspapers: the NAS may receive a request for photos to accompany and illustrate articles on ASDs.

Other organisations involved with the NAS: requests from, for example, Charitable Trusts for photos to use in their publications. These organisations may fund a particular NAS project, and so want a photo which depicts the kind of work they have been involved with. Another example might be a request from a book publisher for a photo to use in a book about ASDs.

With any requests from organisations we never give names of people in photos and we ensure the photos are used in a positive way.
